


One morning at the Ant-hill...




If you find anything, remember to come back to the Ant-hill and to inform the others. Get help from others if you can't carry it alone!

The little Red Ant takes a small bite from it.


This smells so sweet and tastes so good. I could just stay here and eat this the whole day!




He tries to pull it back home, but it's too heavy

But there are hundreds of us in the Ant-hill. Once this is shared among all of us, I will only get a very tiny piece!




Maybe I should keep this as a secret!

After awhile Red gets a craving to taste the sweet again.




But when Red goes near the sweet, he sees an unwelcomed visitor with his sweet.




Really? Who handed it to you, you silly little Ant? If it's yours, why was it here all this time? I saw it first and it's mine!

By being greedy and selfish, I lost my chance of enjoying it. If I was willing to share it, this wouldn't have happened!




If I got the help of others. it would have been in the Ant-hill by now!



Together with my friends, I could have carried it back home very easily!


Hey Red, what are you doing there? Come here and help us carry this piece of cake back home!
