A Great Person - Leonardo Da Vinci

Leonardo Da Vinci was a person who had many talents and who engaged in technical innovations. He was a wise scientist, a glorious artist, a great explorer, a talented musician and an enthusiastic engineer too.

Da Vinci was born on April 15, 1452. His father was a rich lawyer who lived in the city of Florence.

When Da Vinci was 30 years old he joined the army as an army engineer as it was his ambition. During this period he engaged in a lot of research and made rough sketches of army trucks, fire guns, cannons and other tools and equipment. needed for a soldier.

Then he was an interior decorator in the city

called Milan. He was well organised in the country as a good technician. He used his deep technical knowledge and constructed valleys, bridges, streets The art was awarded and highways, springs and waterways, mosques and churches, flights of steps with various shapes, pavements and lampposts etc.

The plans of air planes made by him too are great. He didn't work only on sketches but also he made projects on them and succeeded in many achievements.

He was an all-rounder in art, which made him very famous around the world. The most valuable art, 'The Last Supper,' was completed by Da Vinci in 1497. The 'Mona Lisa' was well known

world-wide as it took three years to complete, facing many challenges. He started painting it in 1503 and finished in 1506. many times due to it being splendid, delightful and meaningful. The first copy of the art which is very valuable is displayed at the Louvre Museum in France, at present.

He spent his last days of life in Rome and died in his 67th year in 1519.

He was a versatile person who set an example for young achievers.
